## Privacy Policy

### 1. Introduction

Wandsworth Juniors Netball Club (“the Club”) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy explains how we collect, use, store and protect personal data in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

For the purposes of data protection law, the Club is the **Data Controller**.

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### 3. What Personal Data We Collect

We may collect the following information:

#### For Junior Members (Under 18)

- Name
- Date of birth
- Address
- Parent/Carer contact details
- Emergency contact information
- Medical information relevant to participation
- England Netball membership number
- Attendance and performance records

## For Parents/Carers

- Name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Relationship to child

## For Coaches & Volunteers

- Name
  - Contact details
  - DBS status
  - Qualifications
  - Safeguarding training records
  - England Netball membership number
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## 4. How We Collect Data

We collect information when:

- You complete a membership form
  - You register with England Netball
  - You contact the club
  - You participate in club activities
  - You volunteer with the club
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## 5. How We Use Personal Data

We use personal data to:

- Administer club membership
- Ensure player safety and welfare
- Manage training sessions and competitions
- Communicate with members and parents
- Register players with England Netball
- Comply with safeguarding requirements
- Meet legal and insurance obligations

We will only use data for legitimate club purposes.

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## 6. Lawful Basis for Processing

We process data under the following lawful bases:

- **Contract** – to provide membership and participation services
- **Legal obligation** – safeguarding and child protection requirements

- **Legitimate interests** – running and promoting the club
- **Consent** – photography and marketing communications

Medical information is processed as special category data for safeguarding and safety purposes.

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## 7. Sharing Your Data

We may share relevant data with:

- England Netball
- County Netball Associations
- League organisers
- Coaches and team managers (where necessary)
- Emergency services (if required)

We do not sell personal data to third parties.

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## 8. Photography & Social Media

- Parental consent will be obtained for junior members.
- Images will be appropriate and used responsibly.
- Full names will not be published alongside photographs without consent.

Consent may be withdrawn at any time.

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## 9. Data Storage & Security

- Data is stored securely (password-protected systems)
- Only authorised committee members have access.
- Data is retained only as long as necessary for club purposes or legal requirements.

Typically:

- Membership records – retained for duration of membership plus up to 2 years
  - Accident/incident forms – retained in line with insurance/legal requirements
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## 10. Your Rights

Under UK GDPR, individuals have the right to:

- Access their personal data
- Request correction of inaccurate data
- Request deletion (where appropriate)
- Restrict processing

- Object to processing
- Withdraw consent (where applicable)
